The Conference

As stated in previous notices, the funeral director and embalmer exams will be given by The Conference through Pearson VUE testing centers at five locations statewide. All applications may be obtained from our office. The exam fees and applications are to be submitted by the applicant to The Conference. The state license fees, applications, and affidavits shall be submitted to the Board office. Each applicant still must pass the state law exam given by the Board quarterly in Montgomery before being approved for licensing.

Reminder

Anyone who has not renewed their funeral establishment, funeral director, embalmer or practical embalmer license, may still do so with a \$50.00 late penalty until March 31, 2014. If you fail to submit your paperwork and fee, including late penalty, for renewal by the March 31st deadline, the license(s) will be considered lapsed. At which time the establishment (s) or individual must cease operations and or practice. Any paperwork and fees received after the March 31st deadline must go before the Board for reactivation approval.



Immigration Compliance

In February the Board sent a Compliance Requirement Packet, requesting verification of United States Citizenship, to each licensee, apprentice and establishment at their last known address. The only purpose of this packet, as explained in the packet, is to verify the citizenship of the individual who holds a professional license issued by the State of Alabama. This is a requirement under the new Alabama Immigration Law (The Beason-Hammon Act).

The Board **WILL NOT** issue or renew a license(s) until the Compliance Requirement Packet and supporting documents have been received by the Board's office.

Inspection Reminders

Please take a moment to make sure the following items have been taken care of for upcoming inspections:

- 1. Establishment is in full compliance with FTC. (GPL, CPL, and OBC)****
- 2. Licenses are on public display in the establishment.
- 3. Establishment has eight different adult caskets on the premises.
- 4. Individual licensees need to have their pocket license on them or accessible when performing duties of funeral directing and/or embalming
- 5. Any violation that was noted on the establishment's last inspection

Please review the entire inspection sheet to make sure the establishment is in full compliance.

**** Establishments will be charged with violating §34-13-9, Code of Alabama, 1975, if the GPL, CPL, and OBC are not in compliance with the FTC Funeral Rule.
