The Alabama Board of Funeral Service will administer its quarterly state law examinations on **Wednesday, January 26, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, in Room P-103 of the Gordon Person Building, 50 N. Ripley St., Montgomery, Alabama. Anyone wishing to take this exam may do so by submitting proper applications and fees no later than **Tuesday, January 4, 2011.**

The Board will also hold its second regular meeting of fiscal year 2011 on January 26, 2011 at 11 a.m. in Room P-103 of the Gordon Person Building. Anyone who would

like to appear before the Board or have matters discussed should notify the Board office by January 12, 2011, in order to be placed on the agenda. Matters or subjects not on agenda are not guaranteed for discussion at the meeting.

Please Note:

****The minimum passing score for the Alabama State Funeral Director's Exam, that is administered by the International Conference, is 70%.** The International Conference has their minimum for passing set at 75% because

they also administered the national board exam, and if your score is between 70% and 74% on the Alabama State Funeral Director's Exam only, the print-out from the Conference will say that you failed, when you have actually **PASSED!** In accordance with the Alabama state funeral service law §395-X-2-.01 the passing score for the **state exam** is 70%. The Board can not change the scoring practices of the Conference. Any one with questions concerning this matter should contact the Board office.
