Steps to taking the Alabama State Art, Science, or Law exam:

- 1. Submit application to the Board office for permanent license.
- 2. Eligibility will be verified and sent to The Conference by the Board staff.
- 3. Applicants must then go to The Conference website at <u>www.theconferenceonline.org</u> to submit their exam application and payment.
- 4. Please keep in mind, processing takes anywhere from 2-3 business days. The Conference must have your eligibility, application, and payment to schedule. You will be notified through email once you have been processed and you are able to schedule.

The Conference

As stated in previous notices, the Alabama State Law, Funeral Director and Embalmer's exams will be given by The Conference through Pearson VUE testing centers at five locations statewide. The exam fees and applications are to be submitted by the applicant to The Conference. The state license fees, applications, and affidavits shall be submitted to the Board office.

Board Meeting

The Board will hold its fourth regular meeting of fiscal year 2016 on **July 11, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.** in Room 304 of the Alabama State House. Matters or subjects not on the agenda are not guaranteed for discussion at the meeting. **Licensees who attend the quarterly board meeting will receive hour for hour CE Credits for attending.**

Renewal Time & Online System

The renewal period will begin July 1, 2016. The Board no longer mails renewal notices to licensees. Pursuant to Code of Alabama, 1975, Section 34-13-53(d), License renewal applications for fiscal year 2015 will be emailed to licensees, apprentices, and establishment at multiple times during the month of July and throughout the renewal period. The deadline to renew without penalty is September 30, 2016. Failure to receive a notice does not excuse anyone from renewing by the deadline. If you fail to submit your paperwork for renewal by the September 30th deadline, an additional \$50 late penalty will be applied.

The Board is currently changing from Alabama Interactive to IGovSolution for the handling of online services. IGovSolution will offer the following:

- 1. Online License Renewal for all licensees
- 2. Online Credit/Debit card payment
- **3.** Online license lookup and verification A quick way for the consumers to check the license validity of individual licensees and businesses.
- **4. Online Profile Management** A utility application that allows the licensees and businesses to update their address, contact information and employment information.
- **5.** Online CE upload An option for the licensees to upload their Continuing Education certificates/ hours as part of the renewal process (Available <u>2017</u>).

6. Establishment Inspections

All processes through this system are **real-time data.** A change made in the board's office or by the licensees to a licensee's record will reflect immediately on the website for consumers and employers. There will be no time lag or back-end processing.

Instructions for sign-in and use of this new system will be sent via email to licensees, apprentices, and establishments during the week of June 27th.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

Funeral Directors/Embalmers are required to complete 8-hours biennial. Licensees who hold more than one license issued by the Board may use the same continuing education hours for renewal of both licenses without having to earn separate continuing education hours for each license renewal. **The first audits will occur beginning with the renewal period starting July 1, 2016.**

Licensees, chosen randomly, to be audited must submit to the board within 10 days of notification, copies of certificates of completion as proof of completing the continuing education activities used to meet the requirements of the law. Failure to comply with the continuing education audit and requirements shall result in:

(a) The Board shall not renew the license of an individual who fails to obtain the continuing education requirements of this section, except as provide by statute, until the Board receives documentation that the licensee has obtained the required continuing education.

(b) A licensee who fails to obtain the required number of continuing education hours prior to the expiration date appearing on the license shall not have their license renewed until the licensee has obtained the required continuing education hours for that period and paid all applicable fees and penalties.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

The Alabama Board of Funeral Services will offer continuing education credit to licensees that attend quarterly board meetings.
