Dear Funeral Service Licensees.

In accordance with Governor Kay Ivey's Executive Order No. 735, each government agency must complete a comprehensive review of its existing administrative rules with the objective of minimizing regulatory restriction and discretionary regulatory restriction. A copy of The Alabama Board of Funeral Services Administrative Code 395 can be readily accessed on the board's official website at www.fsb.alabama.gov under the "Laws" tab. The board is tasked with the responsibility of determining which administrative rules, if any, impose regulatory constraints upon citizens and businesses, and which introduce discretionary regulatory restrictions.

To provide clarity, **regulatory restriction** is defined as a required action or step that must be taken, or information that must be provided, by a citizen or a business to access government services or carry out its business. *Discretionary* regulatory restriction is defined as a regulatory restriction that is not directly mandated by state statute or by federal statute or regulation.

We welcome your input after reviewing the current Administrative Code 395 of the Alabama Board of Funeral Services. If you happen to identify any rule that falls within either the category of regulatory restrictions or discretionary regulatory restrictions, please forward the following details to charles.perine@fsb.alabama.gov no later than 13, Wednesday, September 2023:

- 1. Rule Number.
- 2. The corresponding category (i.e., regulatory restriction or discretionary regulatory restriction).
- 3. A brief description of the restriction introduced by the rule.
