Mr. Tracy A. Robinson, Chief, Casualty Assistance Center requested the information below be made available to all licensees in the State of Alabama. Please contact Mr. Robinson with any questions.

We are proactively addressing challenges with last-minute requests, which can be difficult to accommodate due to pre-scheduled commitments and resource limitations. While we are committed to honoring all eligible Veterans who have met the regulatory guidelines for honorable service and when resources are available, advance planning is crucial for successful coordination.

We will always strive to fulfill requests and will gladly discuss alternative dates should immediate availability be a concern.

Veterans are entitled to a 2-Soldier detail, the playing of TAPS and the folding of the internment flag with presentation to the next of kin. Retirees are entitled to a 7-Soldier detail the playing of TAPS, folding of the interment flag with presentation to the next of kin, pallbearers, rifle volley teams and a Army Chaplain if requested and available. The team will consist of an Officer/Non-Commissioned Officer in charge with 6 Soldiers that will be utilized to perform as both Pallbearing and the Firing of the three round rifle volleys. Note: The Twenty-one-gun salutes are reserved for Presidents, Former Presidents, and Presidents-elect.

We need to receive your request and supporting documents 2 business days prior to the desired service date in order to complete the request. Requests received after 12PM will start the 2-business day processing period the next business day. ** We cannot support next day requests. **
